Covid-19 Protocol 44Cup Marstrand – V2 June 1st, 2021

1. Covid-19 test required for entry:

A pre-departure negative COVID-19 test. The test must be taken within 48 hours prior to arrival.

Accepted tests: antigen, TMA, PCR, LAMP

- The documentation should be originally in Swedish, English, Norwegian, Danish or French (translations are not accepted), and contain the following
 - name of the person who has been tested
 - date/time of the test
 - type of test
 - the test result
 - Issuer of the certificate
 - name, telephone number and address to the issuer of the certificate, or to the laboratory that conducted the test.
- Test of antibodies will not be approved.
- Please note that the test needs to be taken before departure, it is not possible to get tested upon arrival at the border to Sweden.

2. Covid-19 testing and entry requirements to Sweden from an EEA* country

- Negative test result documenting that the holder does not have an ongoing covid-19 infection, is required. See point 1 for details.
- No further entry bans are enforced.
- Denmark, Finland, Iceland or Norway are Exempted from the requirement to present a negative covid-19 test.

3. Covid-19 testing and entry requirements to Sweden from a non-EEA* country (incl. the UK)

- Entry in Sweden is allowed for foreigners who reside in the following countries: **Australia, New Zealand.**
- Negative test result documenting that the holder does not have an ongoing covid-19 infection, is required. See point 1 for details.
- Must be covered by at least one exemption to the general entry ban.
- Should follow the Public Health Agency of Sweden's recommendations for everyone travelling to Sweden from abroad.
- Fully vaccinated individuals without symptoms are exempt from the following test and quarantine recommendations after arrival regardless of where they enter from.

The following categories are exempted from the entry ban and will be allowed to enter Sweden regardless of departure country, but need to bring a negative covid-19 test if they do not reside in Sweden:

- Participants or necessary support staff in international professional athletic events. The Class Office will have all necessary documentation available.

4. Quarantine restrictions on arrival in Sweden

Quarantine does not apply anymore to EEA countries, UK, Australia, New Zealand and fully vaccinated people. Anyone not included in the above list will have to do a 5 days quarantine on arrival with strict contact limitation with the local community.

5. Schedule and location for Covid-19 testing at the event (fast HAGT and PCR test)

- **30 June before sailing** – on the first official day (practice) of the event – mandatory fast HAGT Covid-19 tests will be arranged on site for all people involved in the event
- **4 July before sailing** – before departure, PCR Covid-19 tests for whoever will need it before departure.

6. Covid bubble protocols that must be followed

The 44Cup Marstrand will be hosted as a bubble event and restrictions will be in place to ensure the safety of the crews, organisers and Marstrand community.

We ask that everyone involved in the event respects the rules the class has set to ensure this event is a success

- Marstrands Havshotell will be the base for the event bubble. A dedicated area of the hotel will be reserved for the 44Cup to use as a meeting point. All briefings and offices will also be hosted there.
- It is strongly recommended teams stay in the Havshotell, a section of the hotel will be reserved for 44Cup teams only to limit contact with the public
- Individual apartments and other accommodation are acceptable so long as limits all contact with the public.
- Sanitising stations will be at the entrance to all common spaces
- The local race management will be based at the GKSS Club House on the island.
- Masks will be mandatory in indoor communal areas – this will be reviewed closer to the event.

7. Safety Measures to follow at the venue

- Where possible crew should avoid using the ferry and use RIBs to cross to the moorings. Moorings on the mainland will be confirmed closer to the event.
- Access to the dock will only be granted to registered participants.
- Social distance of at least 1,5 m should be maintained and respected at all times.
- Masks should be worn at all times in indoor communal areas – this will be reviewed closer to the event.
- Spectators are not allowed in the event area.
- The notice board information, as well as all other information will ONLY be communicated on the 44Cup website and on Planify.

8. Location of sanitising stations at the event

- 44Cup Covid testing station staff on site
- Sanitising stations will be available at the entrance of the hotel and in all common spaces

9. Technical area covid protocol

- No sharing of equipment between teams
- Teams should create sanitising stations at the entrance to their container
- Crews should avoid entering other team containers and the class container
- A clean and sanitise program should take place every evening by each team.

10. Plan for isolation should we have a positive result

- All of the team need to do a fast HAGT Covid-19 test immediately and will be isolated until we have the test results. People with a positive test shall do a PCR test.
- The full team involved will do a 2nd fast HAGT Covid-19 test on the next morning. The team will remain isolated until all team members are confirmed negative.

In such case the organiser will have a venue ready for the positive people to do their 10 days quarantine.
